EVROS WALK WATER 1 & 2



«Once you heard this concert I will live in Switzerland as well» – this was the closing sentence of «Evros Walk Water 1» developed in 2015 for Schlossmediale Werdenberg. Daniel Wetzel had collaborated with minors in Athens to develop a stage set and audio drama in which «Walk Water» (1959) – duration 3 minutes – by John Cage is performed six times. The original instruments and sounds have been replaced by the boys' stories as they talk about their reasons for fleeing their home countries, their journey to Europe, and their daily life in Athens. Since then the piece has done those journeys in Europe that it protagonists could not. «Evros Walk Water 1&2» has been developed in May 2017. Some of the teenagers have meanwhile moved on, they live

(June 2016, Rheinische Post) in Switzerland, Sweden, Denmark. Others have stayed and ask: How is it for you? The concert continues, the instruments alter, as well as the stories.
